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**ANNEX AA (TRAINING GUIDANCE FOR FUTURE OPERATIONS) TO V CORPS
PRE-DEPLOYMENT ORDER FOR FUTURE OPERATIONS MESSAGE # 0311-064**

1. PREDEPLOYMENT TRAINING REQUIREMENTS ISO FUTURE OPERATIONS IN THE XXXXXXXX AOR. THIS ANNEX IDENTIFIES V CORPS COMMANDER GUIDANCE ON PREPARATORY TRAINING AND XXXXXX TRAINING REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDANCE FOR DEPLOYMENT INTO THEIR AOR.

2. UNIT COMMANDERS WILL ENSURE DEPLOYING FORCES ARE TRAINED, AND CERTIFIED TO ACCOMPLISH THE ASSIGNED MISSION IN THE XXXXXXXX AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (AOR). COMMANDERS OF DEPLOYING UNITS WILL CONDUCT TRAINING IN GENERAL, INDIVIDUAL TASKS, THEATER SPECIFIC INDIVIDUAL AND LEADER TASKS, METL TASKS, AND THEATER SPECIFIC COLLECTIVE TASKS. AT END STATE, UNITS ARE PROFICIENT IN THE TASKS REQUIRED TO ACCOMPLISH THE ASSIGNED MISSION AND THE UNIT HAS BEEN CERTIFIED TO PERFORM THE MISSION.

A. CERTIFICATION. THIS PROCEDURE IS PERFORMED BY COMMANDERS AT THE DIVISION/SEPARATE BRIGADE LEVEL EQUIVALENT AND BELOW.

1. COMMANDER'S ARE AUTHORIZED TO ADD ADDITIONAL TRAINING TASKS BASED UPON MISSION ANALYSIS.

2. COMMANDER'S OF DEPLOYING UNITS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR DEVELOPING TRAINING PLANS TO SUPPORT THE PREPARATION OF THEIR UNITS, WHERE SUPPORT IS NOT ALREADY PLANNED.

3. DIVISION AND BRIGADE SEPARATE COMMANDERS WILL ENSURE THEIR UNITS COMPLETE ALL REQUIRED TRAINING AND IS PROFICIENT IN THEIR ABILITY TO PERFORM THE ASSIGNED MISSION.

3. CERTIFICATION PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS BY CATEGORIES OF TRAINING.

A. INDIVIDUAL TRAINING – GENERAL. (RECERTIFIED BETWEEN C DAY AND DEPLOYMENT DAY). ALL DEPLOYING SOLDIERS WILL BE PROFICIENT IN THOSE TASKS IDENTIFIED IN THIS WARNO PRIOR TO DEPLOYMENT. THE FIRST COL/O-6 LEVEL COMMANDER IN THE SOLDIERS' CHAIN-OF-COMMAND WILL ENSURE ALL TASKS ARE TRAINED TO STANDARD.

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(1) EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, THE FIELD UNIFORM WILL INCLUDE WEARING PERSONAL BODY ARMOR FOR ALL PREDEPLOYMENT TRAINING. WEAR KEVLAR, LBV, AND MASK IAW V CORPS CG'S GUIDANCE.

(2) ALL COMBAT UNITS WILL DEPLOY AT C1 READINESS WITH 100% PERSONNEL FILL ON MAJOR COMBAT SYSTEMS. PRIORITY OF FILL IS TO TANKS, BRADLEYS, KIWAS, APACHES, ARTILLERY AND MORTAR SYSTEMS.

(3) COMBAT SUPPORT AND COMBAT SERVICE SUPPORT UNITS WILL DEPLOY AT A MINIMUM OF C2 READINESS.

(4) ALL DOD CIVILIANS AND DOD CONTRACTORS MUST MEET MINIMUM TRAINING REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN DA PAM 690-47, DA CIVILIAN EMPLOYEE DEPLOYMENT GUIDE, DTG 1 NOV 95.

B. INDIVIDUAL TASK TRAINING – THEATER SPECIFIC. ALL DEPLOYING SOLDIERS WILL BE PROFICIENT IN THOSE INDIVIDUAL TASKS IDENTIFIED IN APPENDIX 1. THE FIRST COL/O-6 LEVEL COMMANDER IN THE SOLDIERS' AND LEADERS' CHAIN-OF-COMMAND WILL ENSURE ALL TASKS HAVE BEEN TRAINED ACCORDING TO STANDARD.

C. COLLECTIVE TRAINING - GENERAL. ALL TANK, BRADLEY, APACHE, KIOWA, PALADIN AND MLRS **CREWS** MUST BE 100% FILLED AND QUALIFIED THROUGH TABLE VIII QUALIFICATION WITHIN SIX MONTHS PRIOR TO DEPLOYMENT. ALL TANK AND BRADLEY **PLATOONS** MUST HAVE QUALIFIED ON TABLE XII WITHIN 12 MONTHS OF DEPLOYMENT. PALADIN AND MLRS ARTILLERY **BATTERIES** MUST BE QUALIFIED AND CERTIFIED WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF DEPLOYMENT. ALL MORTAR **CREWS** MUST BE 100% FILLED AND QUALIFIED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF DEPLOYMENT. UNITS WILL QUALIFY NEEDED CREWS IAW THE CORPS TWO-MINUTE DRILL (APPENDIX 2) AND THE SUPPORT WARNO (APPENDIX 3)

D. COLLECTIVE TRAINING – THEATER SPECIFIC. UNITS/ELEMENTS WILL TRAIN THE TASKS LISTED IN APPENDIX 1 TO ANNEX AA (ATTACHED TO THIS DOCUMENT). THE COMMANDER TWO ECHELONS ABOVE THE RESPECTIVE UNIT WILL ENSURE ALL DESIGNATED TASKS ARE TRAINED TO STANDARD.

E. METL TRAINING. ALL DEPLOYING UNITS WILL BE TRAINED TO STANDARD IN THEIR RESPECTIVE WARFIGHTING METL PRIOR TO

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DEPLOYMENT. THE COMMANDER ONE ECHELON ABOVE THE RESPECTIVE UNIT WILL ENSURE THAT ALL TASKS HAVE BEEN TRAINED TO STANDARD.

F. ANY INDIVIDUAL REPLACEMENT ENTERING THE XXXXXXXX AOR WILL HAVE A LETTER SIGNED BY THEIR COL/O-6 LEVEL COMMANDER CERTIFYING THAT INDIVIDUAL IS FULLY QUALIFIED FOR DEPLOYMENT. FOR UNITS ALREADY DEPLOYED, THE REAR DETACHMENT COMMANDER MAY SIGN THE MEMORANDUM CERTIFYING THE INDIVIDUAL AS BEING FULLY QUALIFIED FOR DEPLOYMENT. FULLY QUALIFIED IS DEFINED AS HAVING COMPLETING THOSE TASKS, WHERE APPLICABLE.
